Dear Parents, Staff and Members of the School Community

Dysart School Expansion Consultation

I am writing to let you know about the planned consultation on expansion of Dysart School. The proposal is for Dysart School to educate additional children with special education needs across the existing year groups at its **current site** and at a **proposed additional site**. The overall increase **across both sites** would provide a further 29 places above the school's current Funding Agreement of 96 places bringing the total school capacity to 125 places by 2020.

The proposed additional site would be located at School Lane Community Centre, Tolworth, which is half a mile from the main school site. Kingston Council would provide and refurbish the additional site which will cater for up to seven children in the 2019/2020 school year and up to a capacity of 15 places in the 2020/2021 school year.

This expansion would give us the opportunity to offer more places for children and young people with special educational needs, in the local area, so they can benefit from our teaching and learning and from the inclusion opportunities provided by the location of the proposed additional site which is adjacent to Tolworth Infant and Junior Schools.

Achieving for Children (AfC), the community interest company that provides Children's Services for Kingston Council, has identified a need for more special school places to be provided locally and as quickly as possible. This is due to the growth of the general school-aged population in the borough, and because the number of pupils requiring specialist education is rising at an even faster rate.

AfC and Kingston Council work very closely with us to ensure that our offer meets the local requirements and complements other local provision. These proposals would enable us to continue to have the best possible local offer within the constraints of our site and the funding available.

As Dysart School is an academy, the expansion proposal would need to be approved by the Department for Education (DfE) and we are therefore seeking the views of parents and other interested parties through this consultation in order to inform the DfE's decision-making process and to change the Funding Agreement to 125 places.

Please see the attached questions; I would be extremely grateful for your views and any other thoughts you might have on this proposal. Our families and wider school community are at the heart of what we do and we want to be sure that this is the right move, not only for Dysart School but for the local community.

A consultation on the proposal will run from Wednesday 24th April 2019 to Thursday 23rd May 2019. A public meeting will be held at 5pm on Tuesday 30th April 2019 at Dysart School.
